The next Jewish-Christian Dialogue will be Wednesday, November 15 at 7:30 P. M. at Visitation Monastery, 2300 Springhill Avenue.

We will be given a tour through parts of the Monastery, and will have the opportunity to meet and visit with the Nuns for a short time.

Fr. Richard W. Rousseau, S. J. will be our speaker for the evening. His topic is "The Trinity in Christian Life and Thought."

Fr. Rousseau brings to the Mobile area a wealth of theological knowledge and experience. He graduated from Boston College with Masters Degrees in Philosophy and English, from St. Albert de Louvain in Historical Theology. He also holds a degree from St Paul's University in Ottawa, Canada, and a Doctorate in Historical Theology from Ottawa University. He has taught Theology at Boston College and Fairfield University and is the former Dean of the Weston School of Theology in Cambridge, Mass.

He is the author of numerous publications, articles and book reviews, as well as the founder and director of the National Workshop on Christian Unity and has lectured in many parts of the country on Church renewal and Ecumenism.

We are fortunate to have Fr. Rousseau at Spring Hill College and as our speaker this month.

We are looking forward to seeing all of you on November 15 at the Monastery.
