THE LITURGY OF LENT AND JEWISH-CHRISTIAN RELATIONS

Dr. Fisher was named Executive Secretary of the Secretariat for Catholic-Jewish Relations of the National Conference of Catholic Bishops (NCCB) in May of 1977. He is the first layperson to hold the NCCB post. His doctoral degree is in Hebrew Culture and Education from New York University. Dr. Fisher has lectured widely throughout the United States, Canada and Europe, and has published almost 100 articles in major religious journals. He has also published several volumes, including: FAITH WITHOUT PREJUDICE; HOMEWORK FOR CHRISTIANS PREPARING FOR JEWISH-CHRISTIAN DIALOGUE; and most recently, SEMINARY EDUCATION AND CATHOLIC-JEWISH RELATIONS.

In April of 1981, Dr. Fisher was appointed Consultor to the Vatican Commission for Religious Relations with the Jews. He is one of eight consultors worldwide and the only American on the Commission. In addition to his many honors and consultantships, Dr. Fisher serves in many varied capacities including: National Program Committee, National Conference of Christians and Jews. Editorial Board, FACE TO FACE, an interreligious affairs bulletin of the Anti-Defamation League of B'nai Brith and; Special Consultant for the film "The Day That Christ Died" and recently the PBS documentary "HERITAGE - Civilization and the Jews".

We are indeed, fortunate to have Dr. Fisher with us again in Mobile and we encourage you to make plans to welcome him and join us in dialogue. Please note that this will NOT be a dinner-dialogue and will begin at 7:30 not 6:30.
