Robert Jan van Pelt is Professor in the School of Architecture, University of Waterloo, Canada. He is co-author (with Debórah Dwork) of *Auschwitz: 1270 to the Present*, winner of a National Jewish Book Award, 1996.

His most recent "*The Case for Auschwitz*" is an absorbing account of the much publicized David Irving libel trial. As an expert witness, Van Pelt analyses the historical evidence for the gas chambers at Auschwitz and refutes negationists' claims to the contrary. Robert Jan was the chief witness at the Deborah Lipstadt/David Irving trial in London. He is without a doubt, one of the most engaging and brilliant speakers on this subject in the world.
