Speaker: Jerry Darring


Thursday – May 26, 2011 – 7:00 pm – Springhill Avenue Temple

Mr. Jerry Darring, secretary of the board of the Mobile Christian-Jewish Dialogue, is adjunct instructor in Theology at Spring Hill College. He studied the Holocaust at Yad Vashem in Jerusalem and is active in the Alabama Gulf Coast Center for Holocaust and Human Rights Education. He is co-founder and the curator of the Alabama Gulf Coast Holocaust Library, located at the Ahavas Chesed Synagogue and the Springhill Avenue Temple. His publications include *Christians, Jews, and the Holocaust*; *Catechism of Catholic Social Teaching*, *Celebrating the Mass*, three books of meditations on lectionary readings, eight books of Bible study for teens, two Bible textbooks, and eight Sunday school textbooks. He is a member of Our Savior Roman Catholic Church in Mobile.

The three "flashpoints" that Darring will speak about are the Christian anti-Jewish tradition, the New Testament, and Pope Pius XII.
